The Locality Health Centre

The Locality Health Centre is currently changing the way we deliver services so that we are in the best position for the future. This post is central to those changes as we can create a clinically led practice for the 21st Century, with Principal GP's and Specialist Nursing team with strong, supportive admin. We are building on the excellent team approach to create a smarter service. As a Social Enterprise there are no Partner GP's as the administrative, financial and staffing functions are managed as part of the wider organisation.

The Locality Health Centre was established in 2000 as a PCT managed PMS practice, set up to provide access to medical services to an under-served population with significant health problems and inequalities. In 2005 it moved into purpose built premises within the For All Healthy Living Centre.

In 2007 as part of the national trend to separate the provision from the commissioning of services, North Somerset PCT tendered both its directly managed practices. To demonstrate and increase the potential of a community focused Social Enterprise, to preserve the partnership within the Centre, and with the full support of the clinical team, the For All Healthy Living Company successfully bid to take on an APMS contract to provide medical services in the area.

In order to be able to offer access to the NHS pension scheme for new employees, the Locality Health Centre established itself as a Community Interest Company in September 2011. It is still committed to the ethos and purpose of the For All Healthy Living Company and the organisations work as one.

In 1999, the existing partnership of community members and local agencies committed to improving local services seized the opportunity to develop a multi agency, "one-stop-shop" and worked to plan, design, finance and develop the For All Healthy Living Centre.

The For All Healthy Living Company is a Company Limited by Guarantee and was incorporated in 2005 to formalise the partnership of community and local agencies, run the For All Healthy Living Centre and develop its work to improve the health and wellbeing of residents of South Ward. It is increasingly identifying and working as a Social Enterprise, reinvesting surpluses in the local community.
